

# Student Job Opportunities: Visualization Lab Assistants

ITS Research Computing and Cyberinfrastructure is currently seeking a few students for part-time, wage-payroll positions as visualization lab assistants.

These positions are being created to provide a monitoring presence for, to help increase awareness of, and to evaluate new toolsets for visualization labs run by the group. These jobs will provide excellent opportunity for self-starting individuals with appropriate academic interest to develop personal skills in scientific and/or engineering visualization programming, applications and display systems, while representing our group as lab assistants during regularly scheduled daytime hours.

Duties of the position include:

- 1) Being physically present in the lab during regularly scheduled weekday daytime hours during the academic semester (hours will be scheduled to accommodate class schedules, but should be consistent week to week). We are seeking students whose schedules will permit approximately 10 or more hours a week for this activity.
- 2) Monitoring the labs while there for operational or other problems and reporting to group staff as needed.
- 3) Serving as friendly users and/or co-investigators to evaluate and help implement new visualization tools or work flows for the lab. Lab assistant investigations will be matched to the candidate's academic interest wherever possible. This means that for the right candidates (e.g. candidates working in computational sciences or engineering, regardless of the specific discipline), you may be able to use your work time to develop or improve visualization skills relevant to your academic pursuits.

Applications are being accepted immediately and will continue until the positions are filled. Successful candidates can start immediately for orientation. We would like to be full force for spring semester 2008.
